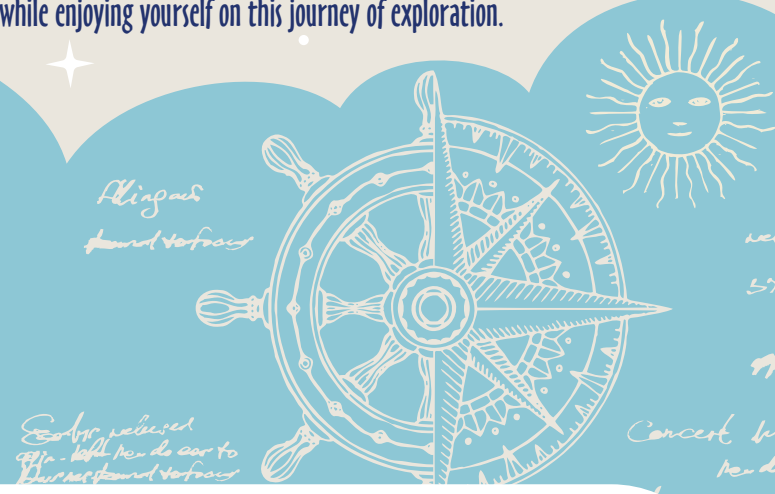

### Stop 1: The chq Building

Did you know that CHQ was home to one of the biggest banquets in Dublin's history? In 1856 a massive celebration was held here for all the Irish soldiers of the Crimean War. About 4000 people attended! If you were going to hold a banquet at CHQ, who would you invite, and why?

Time for a sensory investigation! Explore the Diving Bell, Ireland's smallest museum, and tell us:

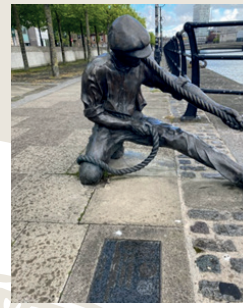
What colours do you see?
